Condrieu is a tiny appellation in the Northern Rhône Valley producing unctuous & exotic creamy whites from Viognier. In 2010 where there was great ripeness, very dense phenolic material and a small harvest, the intensity of expression in these wines can be jubilant. Cuilleron offers detailed orange marmalade & white flowers. It is spectacular with white fish like turbot or rockfish and also with calamari and cuttlefish dishes and can be used as a decadent finish with goat's milk cheeses.

Hermitage vineyards are essentially sitting like a monk's cap of granite atop a very round hill directly across the river from the town of Tain (where Valrhona chocolate was born and is produced). The best vintages for Hermitage are always when that granite cap is roasted thoroughly in the sun. Years of great heat like 99, 03, 09 & 10 are all exceptional.

Côte-Rôtie, M. Ogier "La Belle Helene" 2003 (Bin 313) This is a wine of great purity, soul and spicy, hedonistic character.

Marcel Guigal bottles three single-vineyard Côte Rôtie. Every vintage receives special attention in the vineyard and the cellar. The wines typically spend 42 months in oak casks during their upbringing and often seem to "die" in barrel. A few years later they are reborn when bottled. Uniquely intense and balanced individual expressions; La Turquie is to Beethoven as La Landonne is to Brahms and La Mouline is to Chopin.

Recorking exposes the wine to the atmosphere and changes it. The wines do not see the light of day from the day they are bottled until they are released.

Notice the wines of Elio Altare, one of the key progenitors of the modernist movement in Barolo that began in the 1980's. His wines are all beautiful and reflect his precise methods in the vineyard as well as his lavish winemaking style in the cellar.
