Recently Cindy and I and part of our team visited growers in Champagne and discovered a number of very high-quality, smaller producers. Legras & Haas (Bin 801) is a fantastic aperitif - long, clean, lacy & fine - and will greatly aid decision making on the dinner menu. If there were to be a house Champagne, it would surely be made by Egly-Ouriet, located in Ambonnay, a village surrounded by pinot noir and pinot meunier vineyards. All of their wines are rich & very very dry (low dosage). Most of their wines are made from Grand Cru grapes.

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2006's are well-structured, plushly textured & just beginning to drink. Most of our 2006's will carry you through your meal.

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Pol Roger "White Foil" Brut NV (Bin 806) is a classic, firm, medium-bodied, chardonnay-driven style. Long & nutty with clean minerals.

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Bollinger "Special Cuvée" Brut NV (Bin 803) Classic wine with an assertive mouth feel; perfect for first course & beyond.

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2002 is a great vintage. The wines have really matured attractively and in general are lush wines.

Two producers at opposite ends of the stylistic spectrum are producing Corton Charlemagne Grand Cru. Lucien Le Moine produces a very modern style white Burgundy with robust fruit intensity and very attractive oak seasoning. The venerable house of Louis Latour has been the standard-bearer in Corton-Charlemagne over the last century - wines of complexity and authority, with very layered personalities. Ripe with pineapple, hazelnuts & white dusty stones - these are incredible wines with white meat game and especially the cheese trolley.

The wines from the vineyards around the village of Gevrey-Chambertin are fueled by dark fruit and a dark minerality. These are wines of a particular masculine and spicy character. I like them best matched with organ meats, richly-flavored & fatty meats and all manner of mushrooms.

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Chambertin Grand Cru, Nicolas Potel 2007 (bin 158) is from a thoughtful and talented producer with great terroir in a challenging vintage. It is marvelous, complex, generous & drinking now.

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Hubert Lignier's brilliant & sensitive winemaking is what separates the house above & beyond many many growers in the Côte de Nuits. The Morey-Saint-Denis Ier Cru "Les Blanchards" 2007 (Bin 210) is at once generous & delicate, precise & exuberant. Dark iron rich minerals, tart red cherry pits and a spicy palate beg for rich & interesting cooking.

Clos de Vougeot, because of its variability in quality, is far and away the most under-valued Grand Cru. But the better parcels, in the hands of the best wine-makers, make some of the best wines in Burgundy to age long-term. We have a number of wines from great producers with some bottle age on them. These wines have been unfolding beautifully for years and will continue to do so.

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Jean-Nicolas Méo has to be one of the five most brilliant winemakers in Burgundy for Méo-Camuzet. His wines display more power & precision than I've tasted before. Aromas are at once floral and have a certain truffley minerality. The texture is delicate yet has abundant fine tannins.

The wines do not see the light of day from the day they are bottled until they are released.
